Wonders of the Night Sky

The night sky has so many wonders! Go outside and let your eyes get used to the dark. Then look for:

The Big Dipper: Face north and look up. The Big Dipper looks like a big serving spoon with a curved handle. It might be upside down.

Polaris: The two bright stars forming the outer edge of the bowl of the Big Dipper point to the North Star (Polaris).

Polaris always shows you where north is.

Meteors: They look like stars streaking across the night sky, but they're not. They're space rocks, pebbles and dust that are zooming into the air around the Earth.

Stay up after midnight and go away from city lights to see dozens of streaking meteors called meteor showers.
